

SLOW PLAY POLICY

Las Positas Senior Men's Club Slow Play Policy (effective November 2004)

The Las Positas Senior Golf Club expects all groups in its Tournaments to keep up with the group in front of it. If your group falls more than 1 hole behind the group in front of you, you will be considered a "slow" group, and subject to the policy as noted below.

POLICY: Members identified as slow-playing will be put on a list. This list will be published on the Senior Golf Club bulletin board, in the Golfline newsletter and on the Club website. Members on the list will be given Tee Times at the end of any tournaments they participate in. To be removed from the list, a Player must not be warned for "Slow Play" in their next 2 tournaments.

You may be added to the list when you are warned for slow play by a member of the Tournament Committee (typically the Golf Shop Staff Professionals). You may also receive a "heads-up" about slow play from one of the golf course marshals first. This will not get you on the list, but should be taken as a notice that you are in danger of receiving a warning from the committee if you do not catch up.
